2. THE 2004 MILITARY LOGISTICIAN OF THE YEAR IS COMMANDER THOMAS A. SIMCIK, FROM NAVAL SHIPYARD MATERIAL BRANCH, NAVSEA HQ, WASHINGTON. CDR SIMCIK, AS HEAD OF THE NAVAL SHIPYARD MATERIAL BRANCH, WAS THE DRIVING FORCE BEHIND REFOCUSING EFFORTS TO IMPLEMENT SHIPYARD TRANSFORMATION AND IMPROVE SHIPYARD SUPPLY CHAIN PROCESSES. AS A RESULT, CRITICAL SUPPORT ISSUES WERE RESOLVED, SAVINGS WERE REALIZED AND PRODUCTIVITY INCREASED.

3. THE 2004 CIVILIAN LOGISTICIAN OF THE YEAR IS MR. LARRY GARVEY, FROM THE NAVAL INVENTORY CONTROL POINT, PHILADELPHIA. MR. GARVEY, AN EXPERT IN PERFORMANCE BASED LOGISTICS AND LOGISTICS ENGINEERING CHANGE PROPOSALS, LED THE WAY IN IMPLEMENTING INNOVATIVE WEAPONS SYSTEM SUPPORT, REDUCING COST AND IMPROVING PERFORMANCE. AS A RESULT OF HIS INNOVATION, MAINTENANCE PROCESSES IMPROVED AND NAVY SYSTEM AVAILABILITY SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASED.

4. THIS YEAR THERE ARE TWO LOGISTICS TEAM OF THE YEAR WINNERS. THE COMBINED INTEGRATED MAINTENANCE ACTIVITY FROM THE AVIATION INTERMEDIATE MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT AND AVIATION SUPPLY DEPARTMENT, NAS, NORTH ISLAND TAKES TOP HONORS IN THE ACQUISITION LOGISTICS CATEGORY AND THE NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE TASK GROUP - CENTRAL (CTF-561) FROM THE NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE COMMAND, TAKES TOP HONORS IN THE OPERATIONAL LOGISTICS CATEGORY. THE COMBINED INTEGRATED MAINTENANCE ACTIVITY TEAM APPLIED LEADING-EDGE COMMERCIAL PROCESS IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES TO MILITARY MAINTENANCE RESULTING IN UNPRECEDENTED IMPROVEMENTS IN ACHIEVING NEW LEVELS OF EFFICIENCY WHILE SUSTAINING READINESS. THE NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE TASK GROUP TEAM QUICKLY FORMED FROM FIVE DIFFERENT COMMANDS TO SUPPORT THE LARGEST SPECIAL WARFARE FORWARD DEPLOYED EFFORT IN HISTORY BY BUILDING AND SUSTAINING A FORWARD OPERATING BASE SETTING THE STANDARD FOR FUTURE EXPEDITIONARY LOGISTICS SUPPORT. BOTH TEAMS DEMONSTRATED INNOVATIVE 'FIRSTS' IN IMPROVING PROCESSES TO SUPPORT THE WARFIGHTER.

5. AWARD LEVELS FOR 2004 ARE 5,000 DOLLARS FOR THE MILITARY LOGISTICIAN OF THE YEAR, 5,000 DOLLARS FOR THE CIVILIAN LOGISTICIAN OF THE YEAR, AND 10,000 DOLLARS FOR EACH OF THE TEAMS. THE TEAM AWARDS WILL BE ISSUED TO THE PARENT COMMAND FOR DISTRIBUTION AMONG

TEAM MEMBERS.
